

APPLICATION FOR THE BOND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

The Board of Trustees of the Marysville Joint Unified School District is seeking qualified, interested individuals to serve on the Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee (CBOC) for the implementation of the District's Measure P school facilities bond program.

Proposition 39 Bond Election

On June 5, 2012, voters residing within the Marysville Joint Unified School District passed Measure P. Measure P was a \$47 million bond measure that authorizes funding for needed repairs, upgrades, and new construction projects to the District's schools. Proposition 39 required a 55% supermajority for approval and was passed with the approval of 62.38% of the voters.

Establishment of a Bond Oversight Committee

After a bond authorized under Proposition 39 is passed, state law required that the Marysville Joint Unified School District Board of Trustees appoint a Bond Oversight Committee to work with the District. The original CBOC was dissolved after all ongoing projects were completed, but the District issued the final tranche of \$12,565,745 in November 2018, we will begin new projects this year, and consequently requires the re-establishment of the Oversight Committee.

Committee Membership and Responsibilities

While consisting of a minimum of seven members, the citizens' oversight committee shall be comprised, as follows:

(1) One member shall be active in a business organization representing the business community located within the school district.

(2) One member shall be active in a senior citizens' organization.

(3) One member shall be active in a bona fide taxpayers' organization.

(4) For a school district, one member shall be the parent or guardian of a child enrolled in the school district.

(5) For a school district, one member shall be both a parent or guardian of a child enrolled in the school district and active in a parent-teacher organization, such as the Parent Teacher Association or school site council."

The legislation also prohibits employees, officials, vendors, contractors or consultants of the school district from serving on the citizens' oversight committee.

Education Code Section 15278(b) establishes the duties of the CBOC. Specifically, the Bond Oversight Committee shall:

- Inform the public concerning the District's expenditure of Measure P bond proceeds;
- Review expenditure reports produced by the District to ensure that Measure P bond proceeds were expended only for the purposes set forth in Measure P; and
- Present to the Board of Trustees in public session, an annual written report outlining their activities and conclusions regarding the expenditure of Measure P bond proceeds.
