- Team members hold specialized certifications in the areas of electrical, water treatment, heating and air conditioning, pool operation, excavation, as well as lead and asbestos certifications.
- There are over 50 work-related certifications currently held by the Maintenance Department staff. This year, the crew gained 1 lead, 11 forklift, 3 HVAC, and 3 Backflow certifications.
- We have worked hard to develop a culture of preventive maintenance (fixing it before it breaks). Our Maintenance Department generates more work orders in-house than all the other district employees in our 23 schools.

Our Primary Responsibilities

- We perform the labor needed to complete work orders that support:
 - Over 1,000,000 sq. ft. of buildings
 - $\circ \quad \text{Miles of fencing} \\$
 - o Acres of blacktop
 - \circ Over 3,000 doors and gates
 - We average 3,100 work orders completed each year.
- Most work orders fall under one of these three categories:
 - 1. Student, Staff, and Visitor Safety
 - We maintain doors, parking lots, walkways, fire alarm systems, "all call" and intercom systems, outside lighting, playground equipment, electrical panels/switchgear, and anything else that may put someone at risk.

2. Student, Staff, and Visitor Health

- We maintain heating and air conditioning systems, pools, restrooms, kitchens, water treatment systems, and drinking fountains.
- We maintain infrastructure such as water, sewer, and drain lines.
- We handle air sampling for mold, hazardous chemical waste disposal, and asbestos/lead removal from our sites.

3. Security

- We perform after hour calls for the district and have responded to over 2,000 after hour calls. (Since Feb. of 2008)
 - These include disasters such as fires, break-ins, vandalism, graffiti, gas and waterline breaks, and regular alarm calls.
- We also maintain security alarms, fences, and gates to help maintain perimeter security.

- Over 1,200 HVAC units
- Couple thousand electrical panels
- Miles of underground pipes
- Multiple playgrounds

Additional Responsibilities

1. Regulatory Responsibilities

- Maintenance is the district liaison for many federal, state, county and city departments and agencies including OSHA, EPA, Environmental Health, Feather River Air Quality Management District, and CUPA.
- We track and maintain 152 federal, state, county and city permits.

2. Building Automation

- Maintenance monitors the energy management and building automation systems used within our district.
 - We ensure that the lighting and heating/air systems run as efficiently as possible.
 - We also audit and track energy costs.

3. Projects

- We complete cost saving projects related to construction and building facilities. Examples this year include:
 - Provided excavation, rock, and labor needed for expanding 19,000 sq.ft. of parking lots at Arboga. (saving the District over \$61,000.00)
 - New well and water treatment at Foothill school.
 - Built a snack shack for Lindhurst High School.
 - Irrigation mainline installs at MHS & Kynoch.
 - Rock and grading at bus stops.
 - Converted portable to a storage building at MCAA.
 - Installed 12 new HVAC units at Linda, DO, Arboga, Covillaud, Yuba Feather, Browns Valley, and Olivehurst.

- Installed new carpet at Foothill, Olivehurst, DO, Ella, and Cedar Lane.
- VFD well controls for irrigation at MHS.
- Remodel computer and conference rooms at Foothill School.
- Excavation projects at Olivehurst, Arboga, and Dobbins.
- Fire clean up with new HVAC at Olivehurst. (Room 1)
- Bathroom remodels at Johnson Park.
- Helped with many department and classroom moves.
- and more.

Open Project Board
