Dear Superintendent Thurmond,

Please consider an Agriculture Career Technical Education Incentive Grant waiver request for South Lindhurst Continuation High School. The cost of meeting all the criteria creates a financial hardship for the district and makes it impossible to match with expenditures for non-salary items.

During the 2018-19 school year, the continuation high school matched \$1,498 in the 4000 series and \$881 in the 5000 series. We are requesting a waiver because matching funds do not meet the Incentive Grant funding that the South Lindhurst High School Agriculture Program qualifies to receive.

The Marysville Joint Unified School District supports year round employment for the South Lindhurst High School Agriculture instructor. The teacher's summer service salary, \$9,728, plus benefits, \$1,938, combine for a total of \$11,666.
