1. BUDGET WORKSHOP

Purpose of the agenda item~

The purpose of the agenda item is to discuss the impact of COVID-19 on the state budget and subsequently the impact to the MJUSD 2020-21 budget.

Background~

COVID-19 has had a dramatic negative impact on the state budget, and the Governor's May Revision to the proposed 2020-21 state budget includes a direct negative impact on education budgets.

On 5/26/20, a presentation entitled *Overview of the Impact of the May Revise on the 2020-21 State Budget* was discussed using the detail known at the time. All California school districts must build their budgets based on the assumptions in the May Revise which means a Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) reduction of 7.69%. A special board meeting is being held to discuss the budget changes so that staff and the Board have clear direction on how budget adjustment decisions are made for the upcoming 2020-21 budget.
