The purpose of the agenda item is to request the Board approve the license agreement and project summary with The Regents of the University of California to install and operate the weather station within the Yuba watershed at Browns Valley Elementary School from 3/24/21-6/30/26.

Background~

Approval of this license agreement allows the staff from The Regents of the University of California the right to enter the MJUSD property known as Browns Valley Elementary School for the purpose of the following:

The Center for Western Weather and Water Extremes - Scripps Institution of Oceanography scientists will install and operate new weather station within the Yuba watershed. The station includes measurements of precipitation, relative humidity, air temperature, solar radiation, pressure, wind speed, soil moisture content, and soil temperature at six different depths.

The installation of the weather station supports the Yuba-Feather Forecast Informed Reservoir Operations (FIRO) project, a collaborative effort with the Yuba Water Agency and the California State Water Project (SWP) regarding the operations of New Bullards Bar and Oroville reservoirs.

For example, the data from the instruments will:

- Improve understanding of the spatial patterns and drivers of precipitation and soil moisture within the watershed;
- Provide near-real time data on atmospheric and hydrologic conditions within the watershed
