

## Planning for Emergencies and Ensuring Staff Safety Tips for Maintaining Meal Service Operations During the Coronavirus

This document was last updated on 4/7/2020 and will continue to be updated.

For information on program options and waivers to support meal service during school closures related to the coronavirus, see this <u>FAQ</u>. For more ideas on meal distribution models, logistics, and promotion, see <u>Emerging Strategies and Tactics for Meal Service During School Closures</u>.

## **Staffing and Emergency Planning**

- Assess staff ability to work and their ability to work at different locations as needed.
- If needed, request help from other employees within your organization who may not have work right now, such as administrators, afterschool activity providers, or coaches.
- If short-staffed during extended closures, look into hiring laid off restaurant or food service employees, whether as contractors, temporary employees, or permanent staff.
- Create an emergency staffing plan and contingency plan for closures.
  - o Ideally, avoid maxing out staff capacity from the start.
  - If permitted to serve meals for multiple days at one time, consider consolidating meal preparation and distribution to one or two times per week in order to limit staff exposure.
  - If possible, spread out meal preparation across multiple kitchen or locations so that others are available if one location needs to be closed down.
  - Identify staff who can serve as back-ups should an employee become unable to work or an entire team needs to be quarantined.
  - Create a plan for covering operations or distribution at sites affected by closures, like sanitizing kitchens and pulling in back-up staff, or building up capacity at other kitchen locations and serving the site as a stop on a delivery route.

## **Emergency Communications**

Develop a communication plan for notifying staff, the state agency, local public health officials, and the general public should a site need to close due to detection of COVID-19 among staff.

- Share your communication plan with your organization's or district's leadership team, including the Superintendent and School Board.
- Defer to the guidance of local public health officials, but likely, staff who worked with the affected staff member will need to self-quarantine and monitor for symptoms for 14 days.
- Activate your emergency staffing plan.
  - In addition to contacting staff, determine whether any vendors or partners need to be alerted in order redirect deliveries or change other operations.

- o If unable to cover to gap created by the site or kitchen closure, coordinate with other program operators or vendors who can serve those sites or families.
- o If needed, ask the state agency for support identifying alternative operators or vendors who could help to fill the gap.
- Tell the state agency if and how your operations are changing to cover meal distribution for the affected site or sites served by the affected kitchen.
- Share details about any changes in operations with your organization's or district's communications team in order to notify the public and make any necessary changes to site listings. Or, provide information about other meal distribution sites or resources.
- Notify anyone who may have come to the affected site about the detection of COVID-19, precautions taken, and if and how operations are changing to cover meal distribution.
  - o For schools, this may include parent email, robocall, or texting systems along with the school and/or district's social media accounts and website.
  - For non-school sites, this may include signs posted at the meal distribution site along with the site and/or sponsor's social media accounts and website.

## **Staff Safety**

- If your school, district, or organization has a nurse on staff, ask for support with health education for staff or proactively asking employees about symptoms.
- Ensure that staff understand the importance of not coming to work while sick or under self-quarantine due to possible exposure.
  - Remind staff that they may still transmit COVID-19 without or before developing symptoms, which can take up to 14 days from the time of exposure.
- Encourage frequent handwashing for at least 20 seconds each time.
  - Allow staff to take needed time for handwashing before beginning work and after sneezing or touching their phone or face.
  - o Refer to the Centers for Disease Control for guidance and resources.
- Provide gloves and urge staff to change them as needed, like after touching their face.
- In accordance with <u>Centers for Disease Control guidance</u>, provide masks for staff, both those preparing meals and those distributing them.
  - Request support from community members who could sew reusable cloth masks.
  - Ask if maintenance staff have masks or other protective equipment they could share, or see if masks are on hand for craft or construction activities.
- Regularly sanitize hard surfaces, especially in high-touch or high-traffic areas, both in preparation areas and where distribution occurs.
- Allow staff to stay distanced during meal preparation to the greatest extent possible.
  - Space out work stations and move as many activities as possible, like bagging or assembly, out of cramped kitchens and into unused spaces like the cafeteria.

- o Have just one individual responsible for each task or workstation.
- o Limit how many staff access storage areas or large equipment like refrigerators.
- Deliver needed items to workstations rather than handing them off personally.
- Refer to LunchAssist.org's <u>COVID-19 page</u> for additional safety and distancing resources, including signs and infographics that you can post for staff.

## **Meal Distribution Logistics**

- Implement appropriate safety and distancing measures for your distribution model.
  - Arrange for no-contact meal distribution that maintains six feet of distance between staff and families by using tables or carts, or placing meals directly into the trunk of vehicles, rather than personally handing out meals.
  - o Ensure that families stay spaced out while waiting for meals.
    - Try using chalk, tape, or traffic cones to mark out six feet and show how far apart families should wait.
  - Extend or stagger pick-up times to minimize crowds.
  - o If approved, distribute meals for more than one day at a time to minimize contact.
- For schools, offer no-contact direct home delivery for families that have tested positive for COVID-19, are experiencing symptoms, need to self-quarantine, or have conditions that prevent them from leaving home. Or, refer those families to other food resources.

#### MARYSVILLE JOINT UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT FOOD SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH AeroSTI:M Academy for the 2020/21 school year

This agreement, executed in duplicate, entered into on 26 of June, 2020 between the Marysville Joint Unified School District hereinafter referred to as School Food Authority (SFA) and the AcroSTEM Academy hereinafter referred to as Academy is made for the purpose of providing lunches and/or breakfasts, hereinafter referred to as "meals", which meet the National School Lunch and/or School Breakfast Program meal requirements. It is hereby agreed that:

- A. SFA will provide meals that comply with the nutrition standards as established by the United States Department of Agriculture for the National School Lunch and/or School Breakfast Program to the Academy. The SFA will represent the Academy as the "Sponsor" and will claim reimbursement from the California Department of Education for all meals served to children enrolled in the Academy. Reimbursement will be claimed at the rate of one breakfast and/or one lunch per day per child. Reimbursement will be claimed according to each child's eligibility category.
- B. The delivered price per meal will be as follows:
  - \$3.50/full-paid lunch and \$0.40/reduced-price lunch and \$4.50/non-student lunch
  - \$2.00/full-paid breakfast and \$0.30/reduced-price breakfast and \$2.50/non-student breakfast, if applicable
  - Prices are subject to NSLP Paid Lunch Equity requirements; prices may increase once 2020/2021 meal reimbursement rates are released. SFA will notify Academy of any meal rate increases within 30 days from date new meal reimbursement rates are released.
- C. SB 265 Pupil Meals: Child Hunger Prevention and Fair Treatment Act of 2017 (also known as the No Shaming Act) states that a pupil whose parent or guardian has unpaid meal charges is not to be shamed, treated differently, or denied a reimbursable meal of the pupil's choice because of the fact that the pupil's parent or guardian has unpaid meal fees, and shall ensure that the pupil is not shamed or treated differently from other pupils. A child who has unpaid meal charges, is to be served a reimbursable meal of their choice throughout the school year regardless of the level of debt incurred by the household.

The Academy must make payment to SFA for all unpaid meal charges no later than June 30 each year. Bad debt (unpaid meal charges) are an unallowable cost to federal programs and nonfederal funding sources must repay the nonprofit school food service account for the total amount (Title 2, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 200.426).

- D. For the student account management and associated service involved in the processing of meal applications and Direct Certification, the <u>Academy</u> will be charged \$1.50 per student/per month fee for students enrolled at the Academy. It is imperative to accurate meal counts that the <u>Academy</u> office staff updates new enrollees and drops on a monthly basis.
- E. SFA will prepare the meals in the (Marysville Joint USD/MHS Kitchen) located at (12 E. 18th Street, Marysville). This preparation site will maintain the appropriate State and local health certifications for the facility. SFA will provide the necessary utensils, straws and trays.

- F. The number of meals prepared by the SFA will not exceed the number of students enrolled and in attendance at the <u>Academy</u>. The <u>Academy</u> will notify the SFA of the number of meals needed the morning of service, by 9:00am. The <u>Academy</u> will be obligated to accept and pay for the number of meals requested but not served, at the non-student rate of \$4.50/ lunch and \$2.50/breakfast. SFA will not be obligated to provide any meals on days when <u>AcroSTEM</u> schools are not in session.
- G. SFA will provide the temperature control equipment necessary to transport the meals but will not deliver meals. Academy will agree to pick up meals from Marysville High Kitchen at the agreed upon time and provide all personnel necessary to serve and supervise the consumption of the meals. SFA will provide training to staff of the Academy on point of service meal counts and completion of all documents required by the National School Lunch Program and/or School Breakfast Program.
  - Both parties will be responsible for maintaining the proper temperature of the meal components during the time said meals are in their possession.
  - Academy is responsible for acquiring and properly maintaining hot and cold temperature control equipment at service location if meals cannot be served within 30 minutes of pick up time.
- H. The Academy will return on a daily basis any and all property owned by the SFA.
- I. No later than one (1) week prior to the end of each month the SFA will provide to the <u>Academy</u> a monthly menu for all meal types to be served for the following month.
- J. When requested by the <u>Academy</u>, the SFA will provide field trips meals that meet the National School Lunch Program and/or School Breakfast Program requirements for field trips. Field trip meals will be requested at least 2 weeks in advance. The cost per meal will remain the same as for the regular meal.
- K. All applications and eligibility determinations and requirements for qualifying students for the National School Lunch Program will be handled by the SFA. All records are subject to audit. Confidentially of meal eligibility will be maintained by the SFA in accordance to EC 49558. The online meal application via Lunchapplication.com will be the sole format for parents to apply for meal benefits; paper application will no longer be used. SFA will be responsible for retrieving state-level Direct Certification match, at minimum, three times per year. The Academy will be responsible for setting up SFA administrator with CALPADS access to school profile.
- USDA requires meals for students with disabilities to be accommodated according to the child's physician prescription. The USDA Form to Request School Meal Accommodations for Medical Needs will be required from the child's physician. These forms must be provided to the SFA immediately upon receipt by the Academy. The <u>Academy</u> will be financially responsible to fund any food expense to the SFA for special meals that exceeds the per meal budget for regular meals.
- M. Gifts or exchanges of commodities are not permitted. Until the students consume it, the food prepared remains the property of the State and Federal governments.

- N. The <u>Academy</u> will indemnify and hold the SFA and its officers, employees, and agents harmless from any and all liability, cost, or expense arising out of the performance of the agreement.
- O. The <u>Academy</u> will keep and maintain liability insurance, including extended coverage for product liability in an amount no less than \$1,000,000 for each occurrence and will provide the SFA with a certificate evidencing insurance in the amount, naming the SFA as an additional insured and specifying that the coverage will not be canceled or modified without 30 days prior written notice to the SFA.
- P. Both parties will comply with all applicable Federal, State and local statutes and regulations with regard to the preparation and consumption of meals, which meet the National School Lunch Program and/or School Breakfast Program meal requirements including, but not limited to, all applicable regulations relating to the overt identification of needy pupils, the nutritional content of meals and nondiscrimination. All records maintained by both parties will be open to inspection by proper Federal, State and local authorities in accordance with applicable statutes and regulations.
- Q. SFA will be responsible for the verification process.
- R. Academy will be responsible for over claims and will ultimately be responsible for payment to the State for any over claims identified either by audit or review.
- S. Academy will be responsible for performing edit checks each school day.
- T. Academy is ultimately responsible for the meal count and claiming accountability.
- U. <u>Academy</u> is responsible for meal accountability by eligibility of meals served and transmitted to MJUSD each day.
- V. Academy will be responsible for all fees and updates to POS system and software.
- W. Academy will be responsible for maintaining a Satellite Food Permit issued by the County and correcting any violations from routine Health Inspections. Academy will be responsible to providing copies of routine inspection reports to SFA.
- X. The term of this agreement will be from July 1, 2020 until June 30, 2021 unless terminated by either party by serving a 30-day written notice to the other party.
- Y. All business and information relating to the execution of this agreement and services thereof, including kitchen visitations, will be directed to the Director of Nutrition Services, Marysville Joint Unified School District.
- Z. Payment for meal service is due 10 days from invoice date. Late payments are subject to 1.5% interest charge per month
