SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Gary Cena reported on the following:

- For the past 15 months, throughout the COVID journey, everyone has worked together toward the following four key goals: slow the spread of COVID-19, ensure the health and safety of students and staff, maintain relationships, and facilitate student learning.
- Yuba County remains one of only eight counties still in the red tier in California with a case rate of 6.8.
- Guidance for next school year is to have five days of full instruction with vaccines and masks for both students and staff serving as fundamental components.
- Sponsored vaccine clinics were held at the following school sites vaccinating 528 people with approximately 250 of those being students: Foothill (5/16/21), LHS (5/20/21), and MHS (5/21/21).
- CDC, CDPH, and Cal/OSHA all recommend staying the course with the use of masks at schools at all times for the remainder of the school year.
- Reviewed promotion/graduation schedule.
- On 6/15/21, the California blue print for a safer economy will revise public health guidance and serve as the road map for the summer and next school year.
- Approximately 290 teachers are signed up for Conscious Discipline training during the June Professional Development (PD) days.
- ♦ The District and MCAA will each be presenting the following on today's agenda: the Expanded Learning Opportunities Grant Plan, LCAP Annual Update, and the 2021-2024 LCAP.
