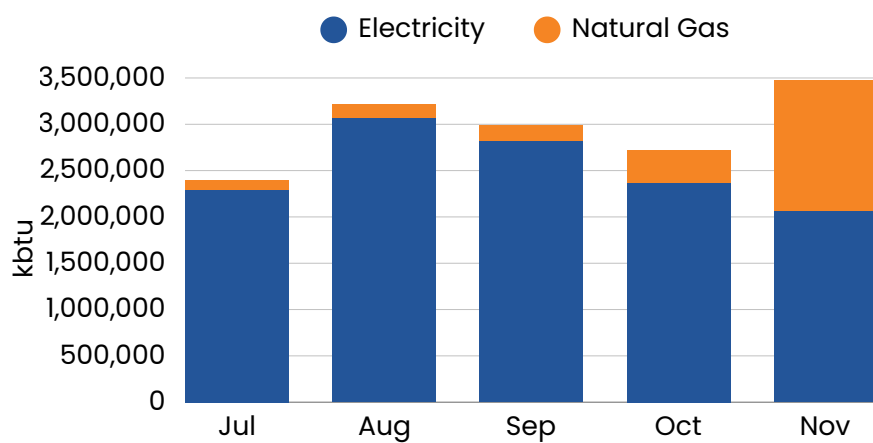
## MONTHLY REPORT – JANUARY 2026

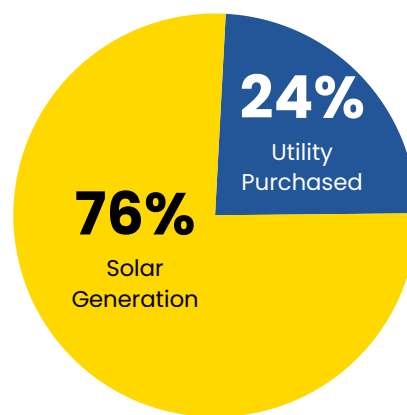

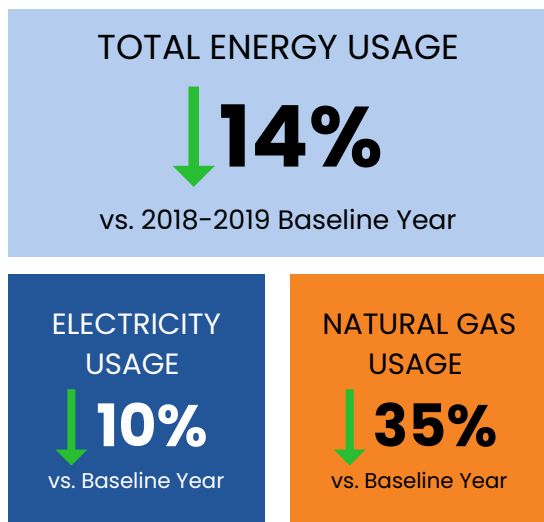
#### Energy Breakdown



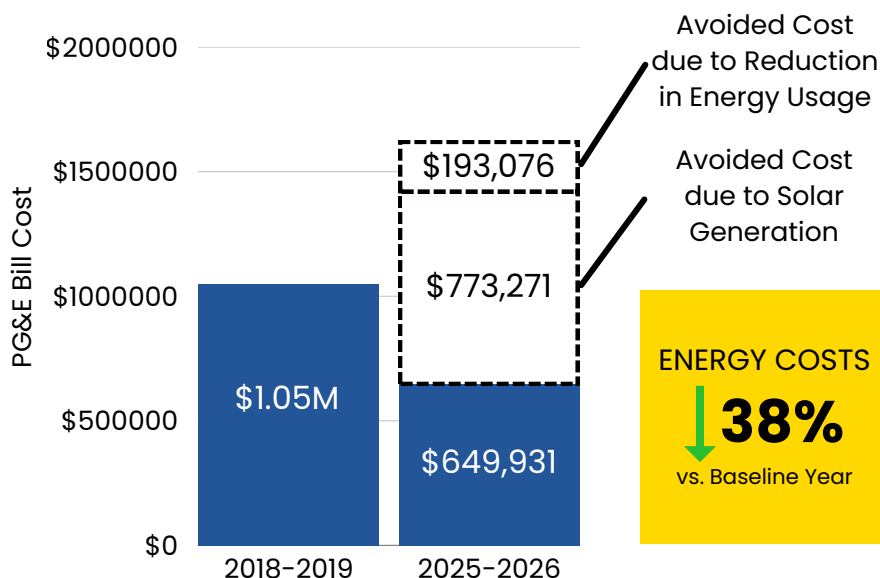
#### Electricity Source Breakdown



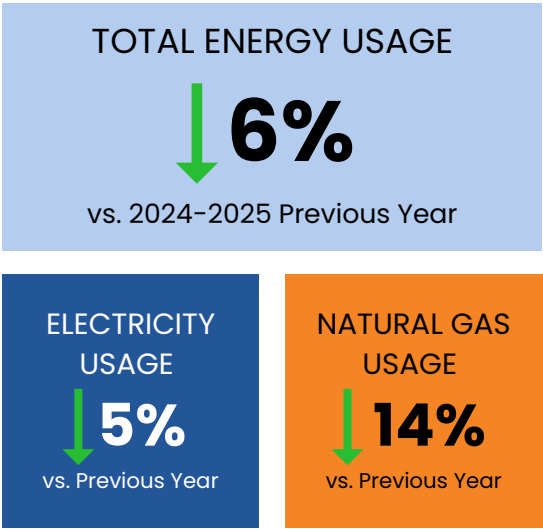
#### Baseline Year Comparison



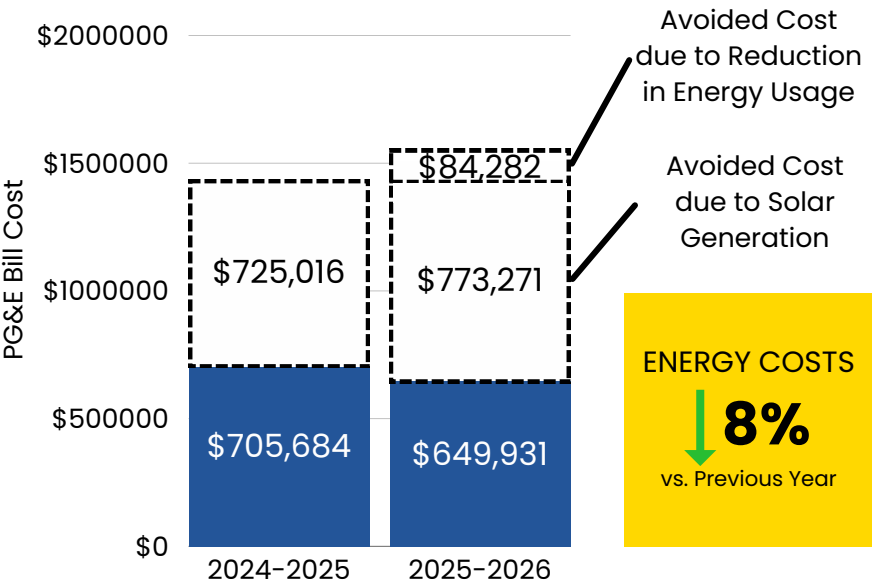
#### PG&E Bill Cost
