Dear Parent/Guardian:

This letter is to inform you that we have been requested to provide the names, addresses, and phone numbers of our students to the military recruiters, colleges, and other groups.

The "No Child Left Behind Act" passed in January 2002 requires that school districts receiving federal funding provide student names, addresses, and telephone numbers on request to various branches of the United States Military for recruiting purposes. In addition, schools must allow the military recruiter the same access to students as they do institutions of higher education and employers.

Under the California Education Code Section 49073, we are required to notify students and parents that this information may be released and that parent and 18 year old students have the right to prevent the release of their student's directory information.

Please indicate on the attached form if you do not want to disclose your child's information. If returned this form will stay in effect until revoked in writing.
