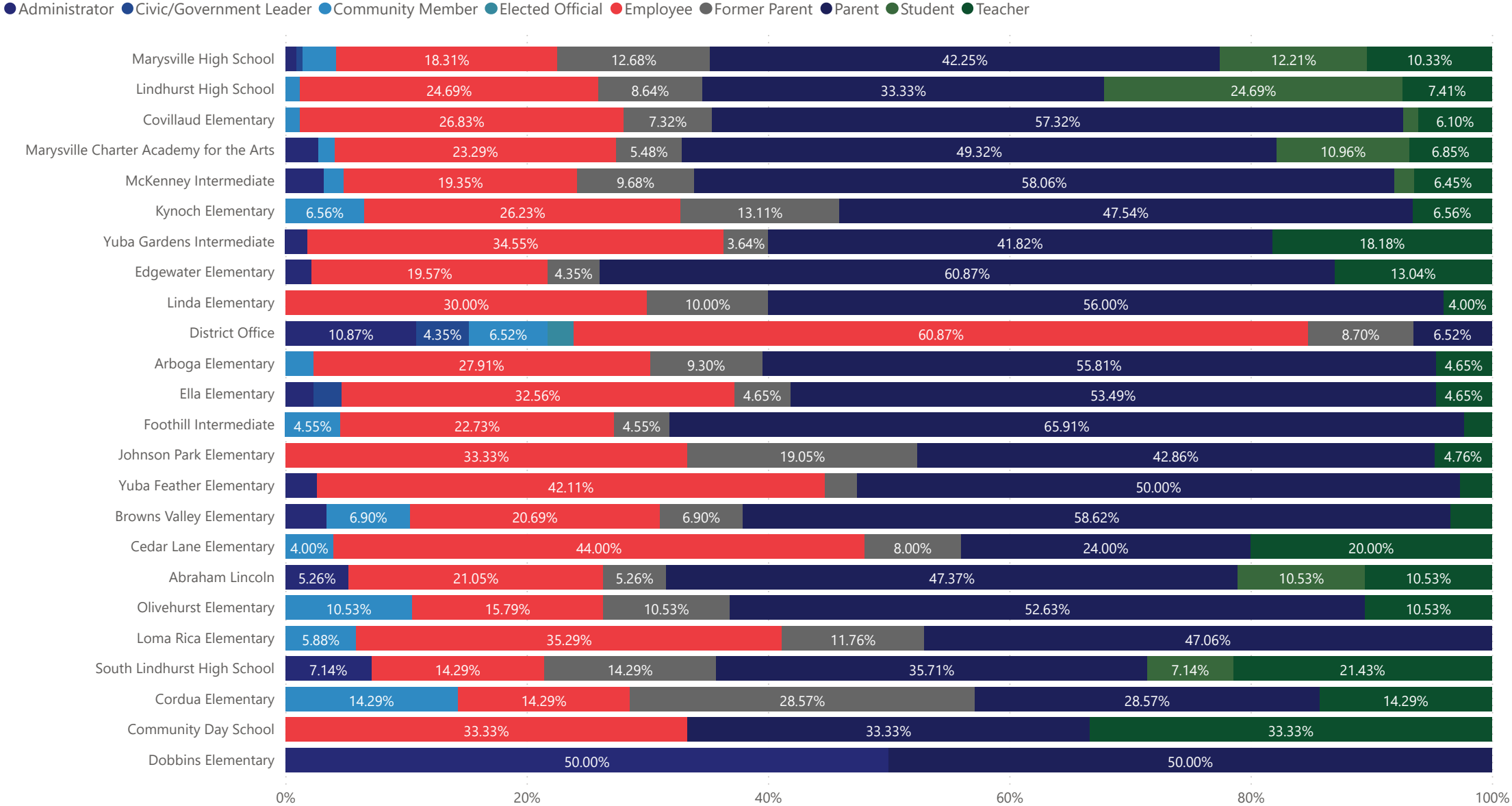


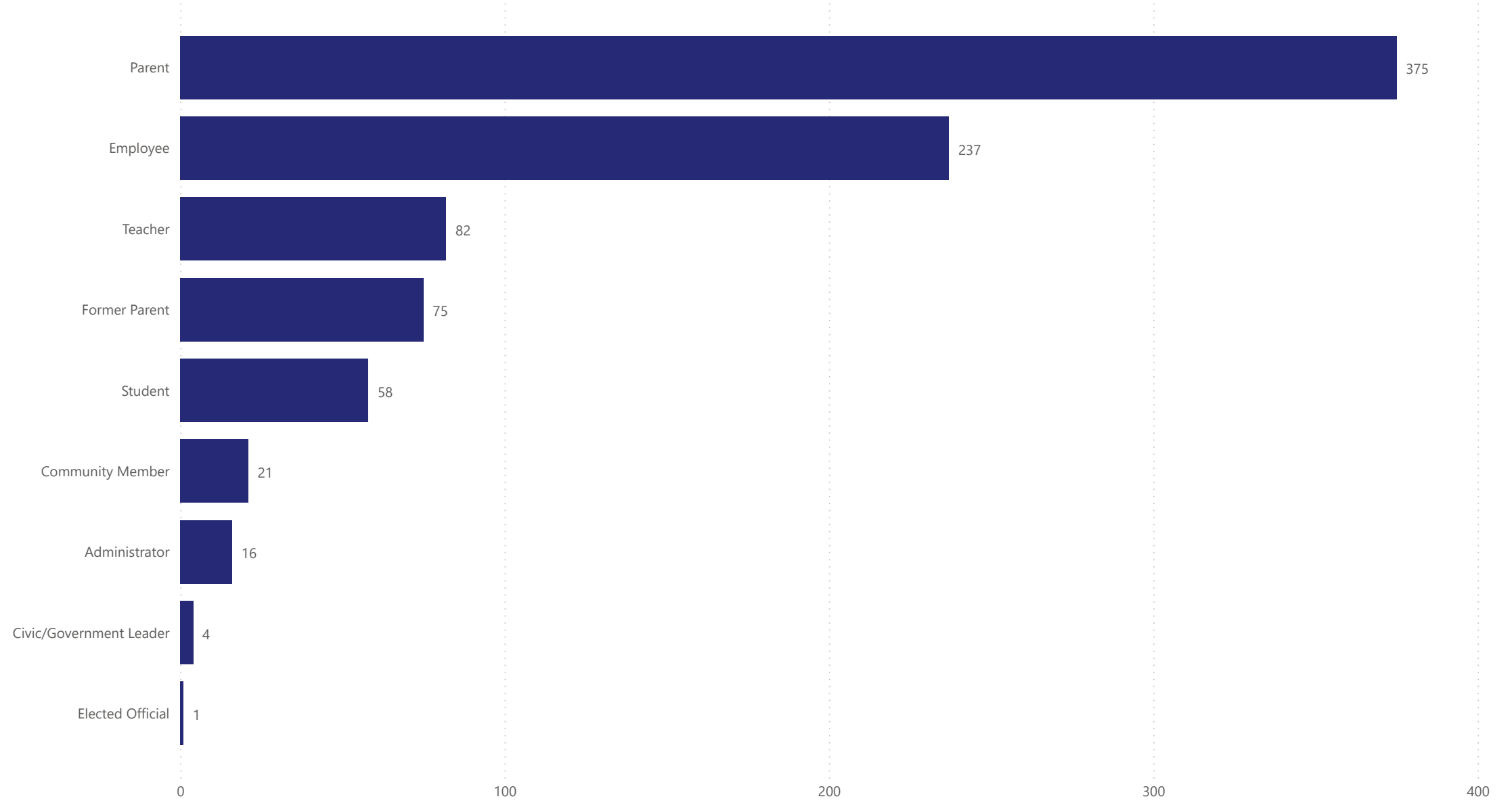

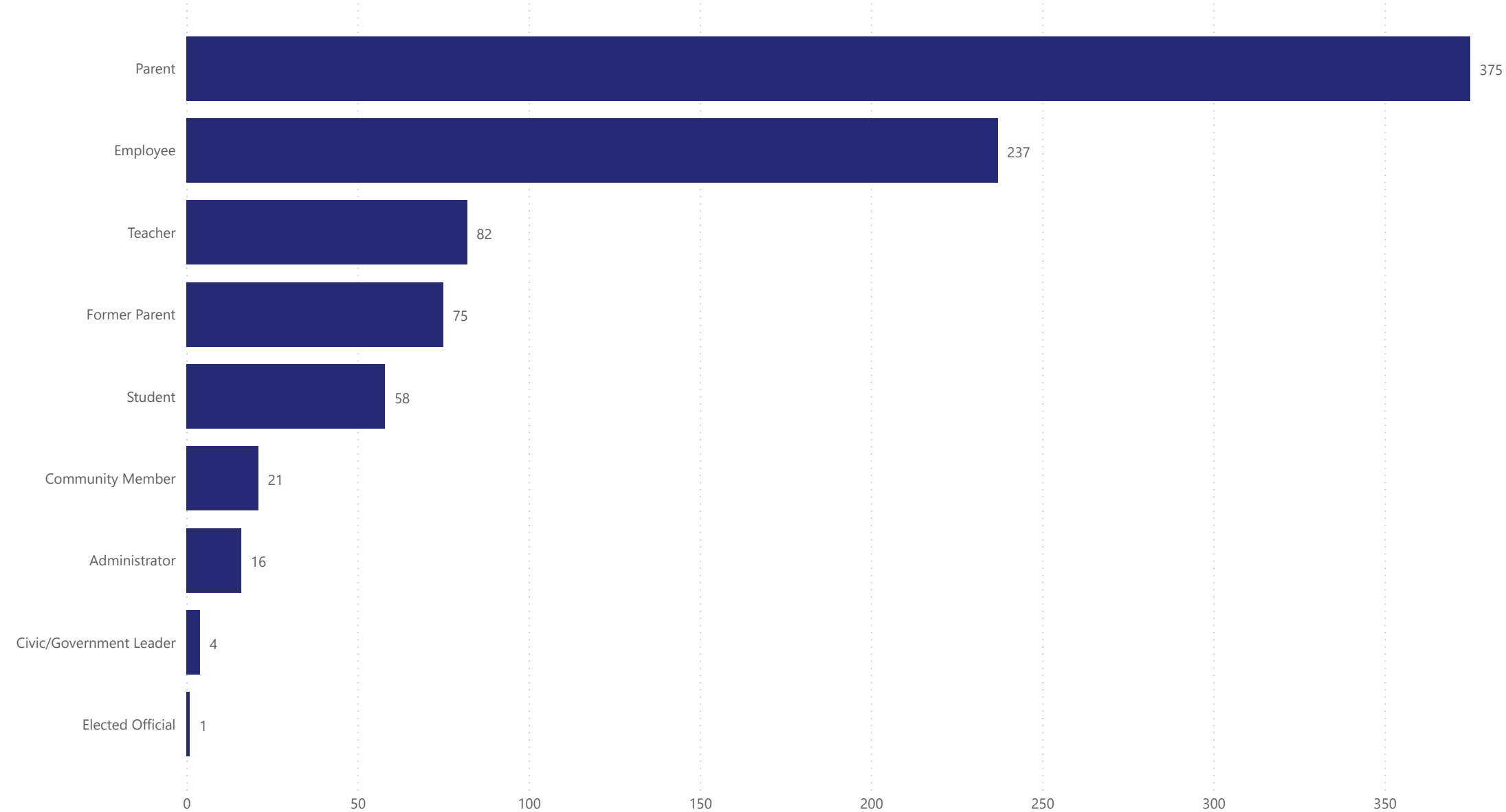
Total Respondents by Site (All, Duplicated)



Total Respondents by Role (All, Duplicated)

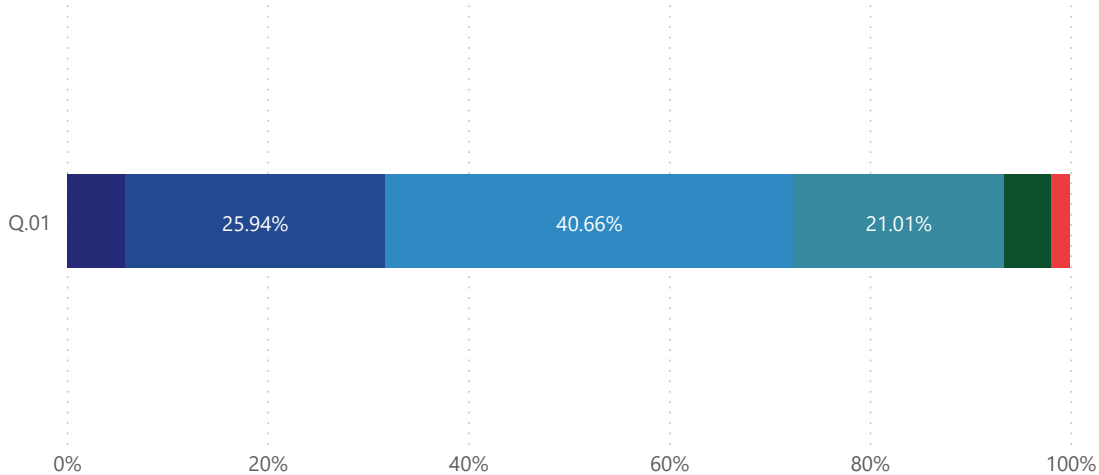

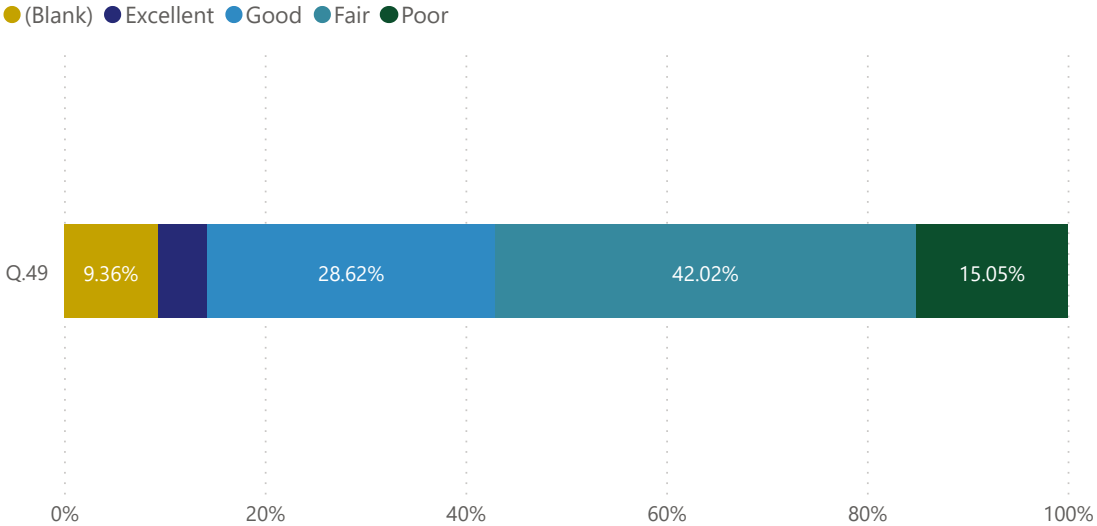
Facility Conditions: What do you think about the overall physical condition of the MJUSD school facilities? Please mark only one rating selection for each item listed. [Science labs]



Facility Conditions: What do you think about the overall physical condition of the MJUSD school facilities? Please mark only one rating selection for each item listed. [CTE classrooms]

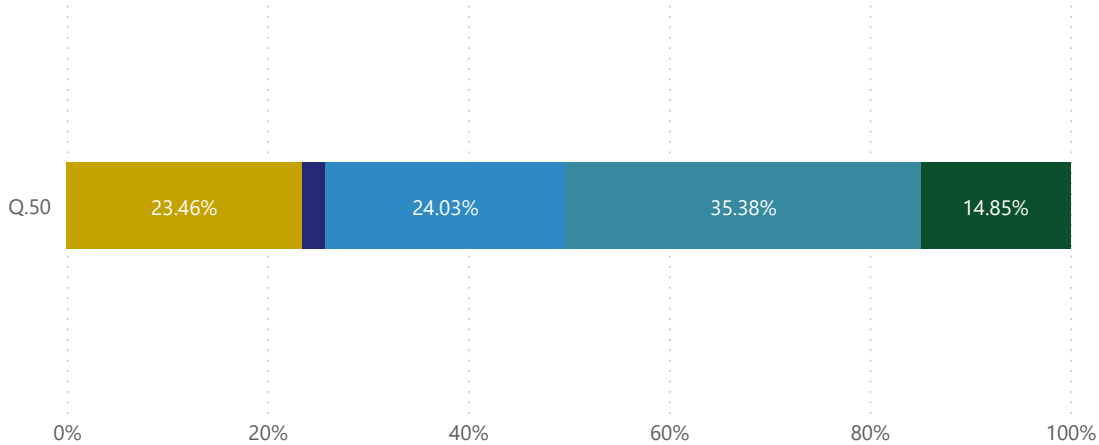


Facility Conditions: What do you think about the overall physical condition of the MJUSD school facilities? Please mark only one rating selection for each item listed. [Cafeteria]



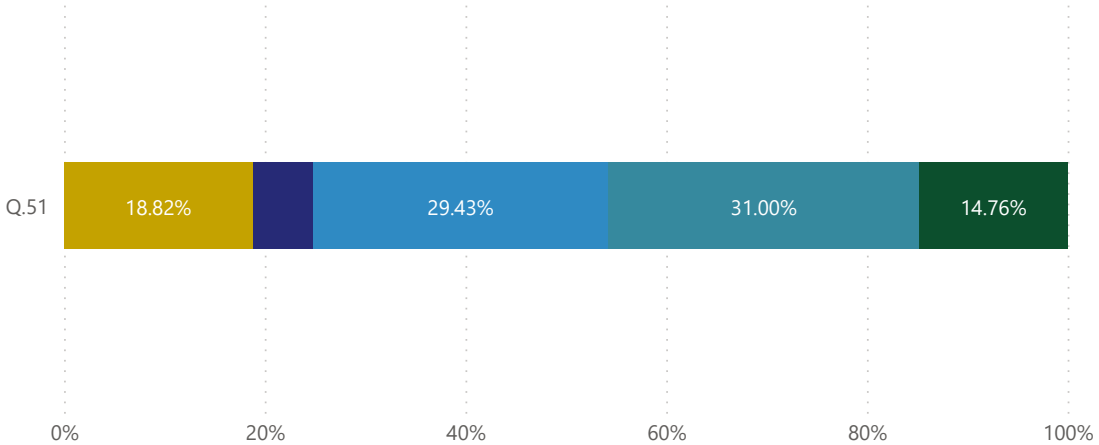

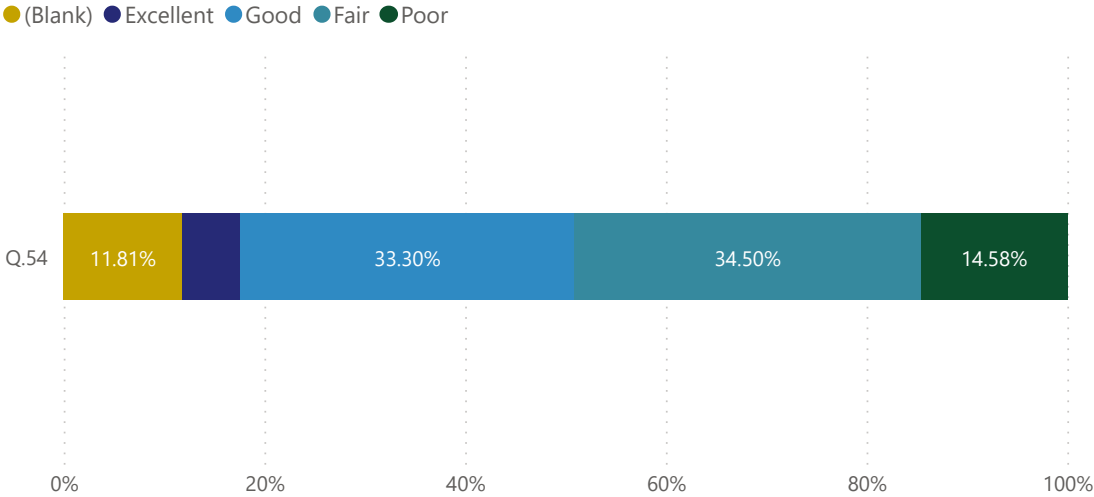

It is a yard track, not meter and therefore Marysville can't host any track meets. It is mainly dirt and small gravel which is very unsafe for an athlete to fall on, which is a definite liability. All of the area large schools have an all weather track which is made of rubberized material which is permanently lined and takes no upkeep. Even Live Oak High has one. They are also MUCH safer and are all meter tracks which means if Marysville had one they could host track meets again. Incidentally, the present facility is condemned due to a person driving their motor home on the track and knocking down light poles and breaking the electrical wires. Also, The discus facility is not anywhere up to safety rules for throwing the discus, which is definitely a liability. In 2020 Marysville had over 100 members on the Track team. More than any other team in school. They were homeless and had to travel to every scheduled Track meet. Oh, incidently, having an all weather track is much cheaper in the long run because of NO maintenance.

The MHS track team cannot host any home track meets due to several reasons: a non-regulation sized facility in both the running and field events, it is condemned at this time, and it is full of safety hazards making it unsafe to be used for home meets or for outdoor physical education classes (P.E.). Visiting schools don't want to come to the MHS campus and compete in a track meet because they don't want their athletes to compete in/on an outdated and unsafe facility. Finally, inclement weather (primarily rain) prohibits use due to deep mud, large puddles and overall unsafe conditions for athletes. This inclement weather delays practice for multiple days due to lack of appropriate drainage leaving muddy footprints, and deep ruts from the several district grounds vehicles that drive on the track.
