1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

Funding was spent on the purchase of materials for music, drama, and art at five sites. These funds supported school wide instruction for music and music performances at one elementary site with 482 students. Three secondary schools provided additional supplies to support art, music and drama. This includes supplies related to drama performances, music supplies to support both instruction and performance, and art supplies to support an increased participation of students. These supplies supported 662 students at the three secondary sites. The alternative education program offered art workshops for 140 students during the school day and family paint nights and supplies to paint a school side mural.
